



How will my child be supported remotely?

Supported live lessons

Some lessons will be taught 'live' with the teacher working with pupils. Support staff and the class teacher will be available to ask questions using the chat function



Pupils can work in small groups or one to one with a member of support staff to help them with a task, ask any questions and receive feedback on their work just as if they were in a classroom

Breakout rooms

Paper work packs

For pupils struggling to use online learning paper packs can be provided. These can be used alongside Oak Academy, BBC Bitesize and other online platforms



A wellbeing call from a member of staff to discuss any concerns and needs from the week. Support can then be offered and sent to the correct member of staff
