Changes to ensure safety



- Most lessons will be 1 hour 40 minutes (on a few occasions, lessons will be 50 minutes)
- Years 7-9 will be in the same classroom to reduce movement around the school to reduce infection.
- All year groups must remain in their own 'bubbles' and must use the designated entrance and exit stated in this PPT.
- All pupils must use the designated toilets and outside area at break and lunchtimes.
- All pupils/ year groups will have a designated place to buy food, it will be a limited menu.
- A face covering is strongly encouraged in the corridors and in social areas.



Hand cleanliness and face masks

- If your child travels by public transport a face covering must always be worn.
- We encourage all pupils to wear a face covering in corridors and other social spaces, however, face covering will not be worn in class. Face coverings must be of a single colour and must not include jokey or offensive designs.
- Long hair must always be tied up.
- No rings must be worn and the uniform policy regarding jewellery must be adhered to.
- All rooms will have hand sanitiser but please ensure to bring your own.



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Break and lunch times

- Pupils will stay in the same bubble throughout breaktimes and lunchtimes and we strongly encourage all pupils to wear face coverings in the corridors and in social areas.
- Pupils will be able to purchase food and drink from their designated 'grab and go' area (from a limited range), using a cashless system.
- Pupils should use the designated toilets at this point and must make sure they wash their hands.
- Hands must be washed or sanitised when returning to the classroom.

Equipment/Uniform

You must bring the following equipment to school as you will not be able to share:

- There will be no access to lockers.

Reducing the risks of infection

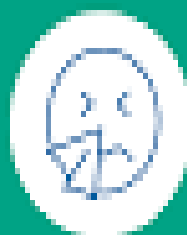
Pupils must:

Behaviour

The following types of behaviour will not be tolerated:

- Making physical contact with others, including fighting of any kind.
- Failure to follow the instructions of a member of staff.
- Deliberate failure to comply with social distancing or other infection- reducing measures in school.
- Deliberate failure to comply with social distancing or other infection- reducing measures on the way to and from school.
- Deliberately touching other people's belongings.
- Spitting.
- Using a facemask to conceal identity in order to behave poorly in the local community.





Bullying

Bullying in all its forms is always dealt with severely. However, since many members of our school community will have been seriously affected by the pandemic, any bullying linked to it will be likely to have an even greater impact on the mental wellbeing of the victim.

Hence the following forms of bullying will not be tolerated:

- 'Joking' about the effects of the virus
