The Jack Petchey Foundation has recently hosted a series of digital meetings between young people, MPs and London Assembly members about young people's experiences of lockdown and their hopes for the future.

One of the topics discussed was the **Government's [Catch Up Premium](#)**, a fund for school students to help them catch up on the education they have missed since schools first closed in March 2020.
